#### **CHPS CROSS COUNTRY**



#### SCHOOL BYTES HOUSEKEEPING

As we reach the end of the term we wish to thank our families for their support and transition into our School Bytes app and parent portal. To ensure we continue smooth communication and sharing of important information we ask parents to check in on their notification settings for receiving alerts from the School Bytes app.

Please see information below from the School Bytes team -

If some parents are no longer receiving alerts when notifications are sent to them, there are a few steps they can take to resolve the issue. First, it's important to ensure that they have the School Bytes app downloaded, as push notifications are only activated with the app installed. If they already have the app, they should check their phone settings to make sure notifications for the School Bytes app are turned on. This can be done by going to Settings  $\rightarrow$  Notifications  $\rightarrow$  finding School Bytes in the list and ensuring notifications are enabled.

Additionally, within the app itself, there should be a settings option where they can verify that notifications are turned on. If notifications have been accidentally turned off, they can be reactivated in these settings. For further assistance, parents can view the status of push notifications from the portal console page under extended support in the left-hand menu panel.




